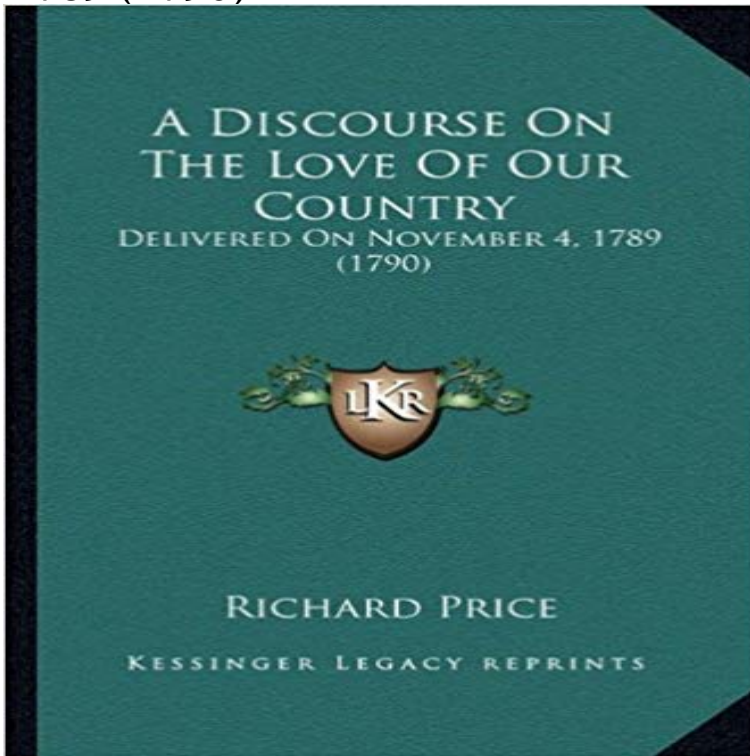


A Discourse On The Love Of Our Country: Delivered On November 4, 1789 (1790)
