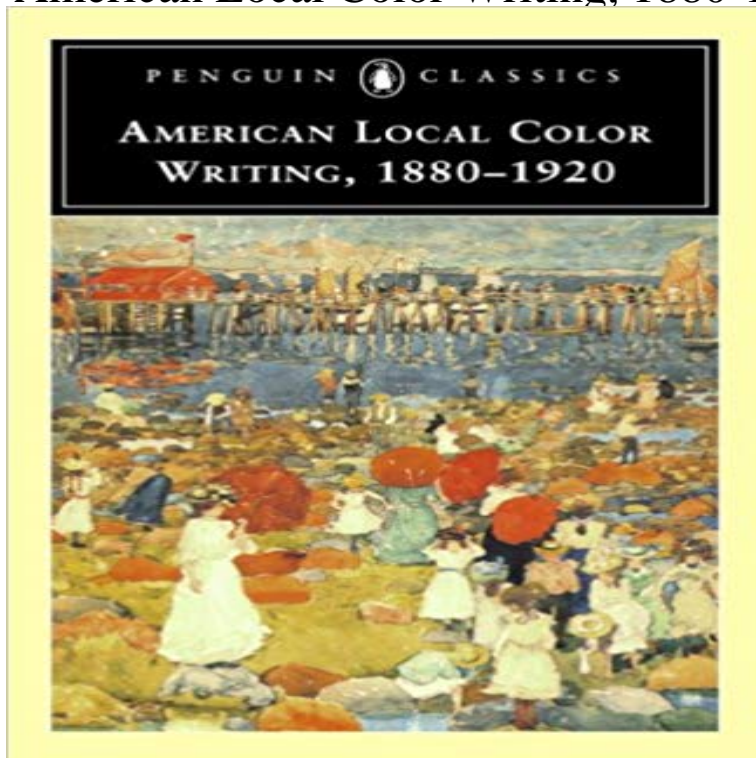


American Local Color Writing, 1880-1920 (Penguin Classics)
