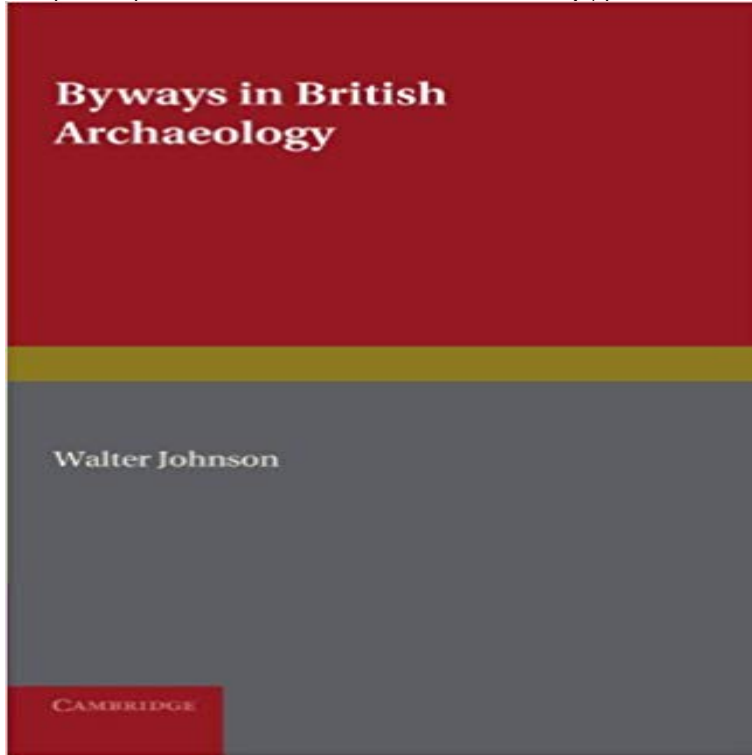


Byways in British Archaeology
