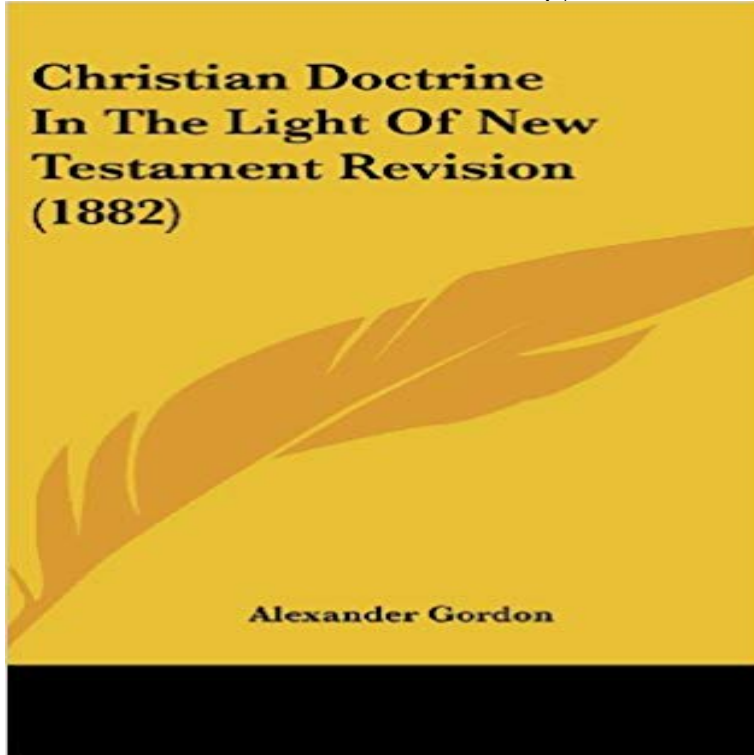


# Christian Doctrine in the Light of New Testament Revision (1882)
