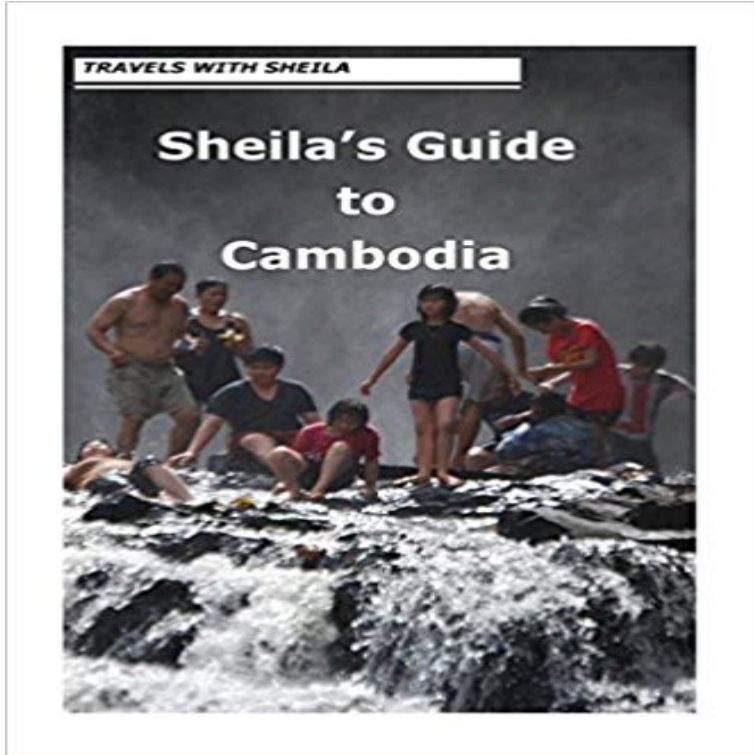


# Travels With Sheila: Sheilas Guide to Cambodia
