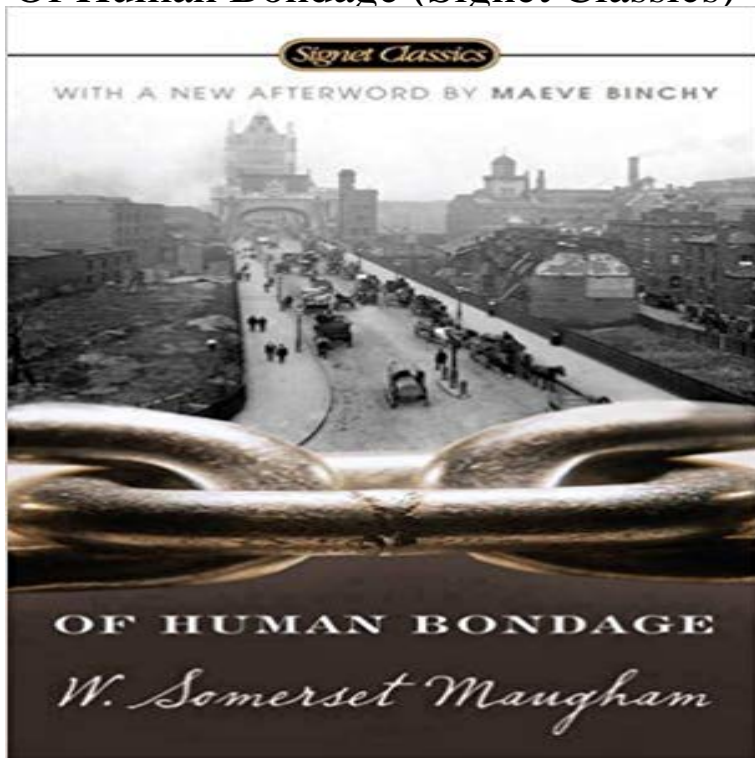


Of Human Bondage (Signet Classics)
