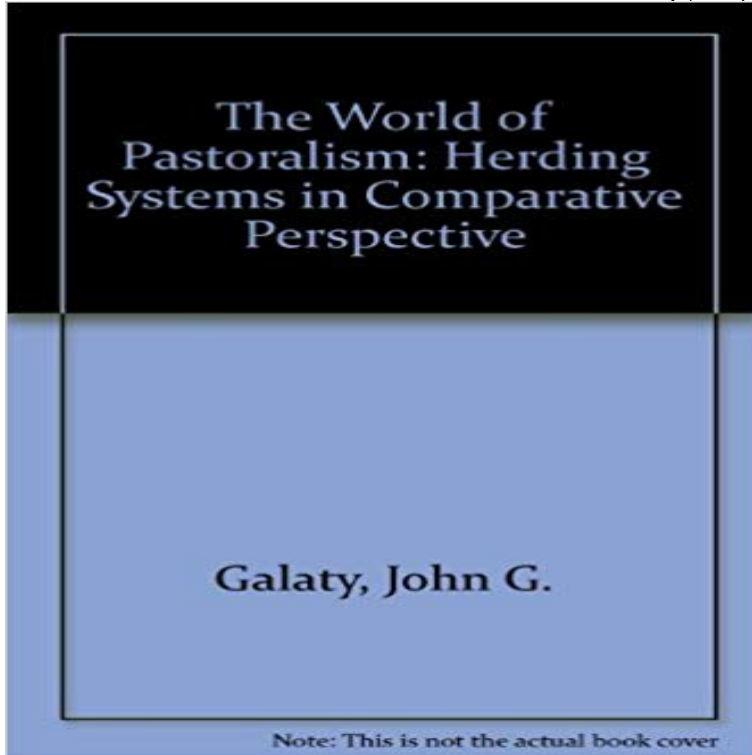


# The World of Pastoralism: Herding Systems in Comparative Perspective
