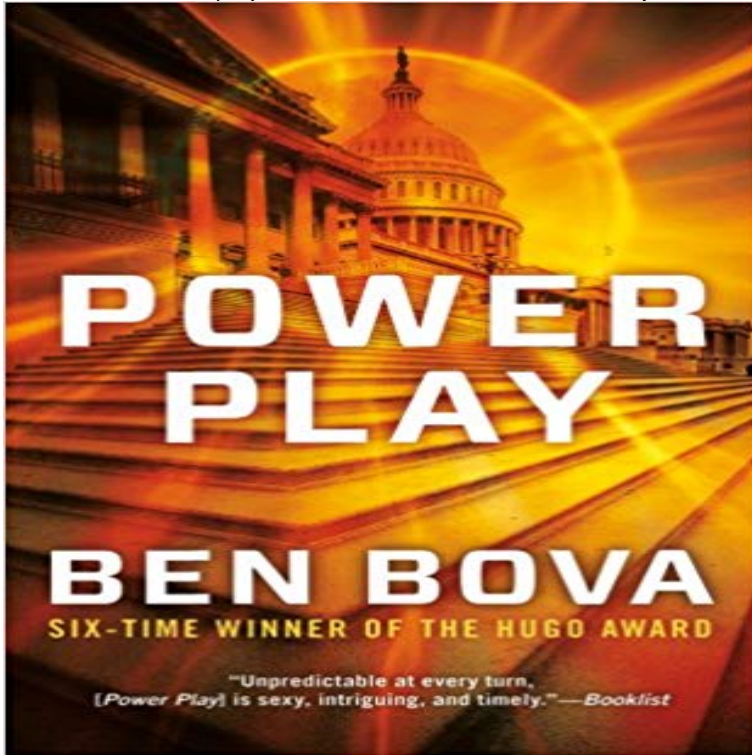


Power Play (Tor Science Fiction)
