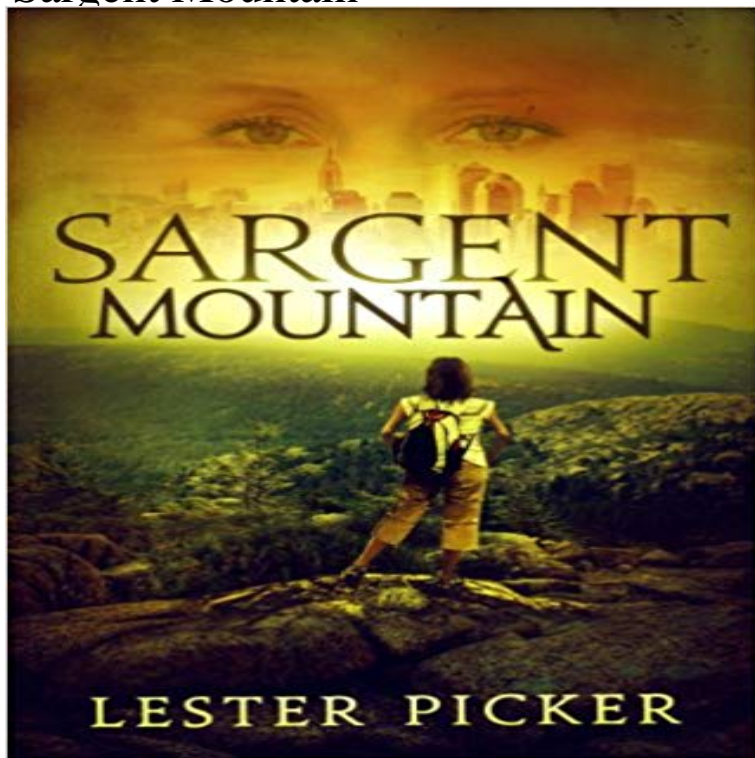


Sargent Mountain
