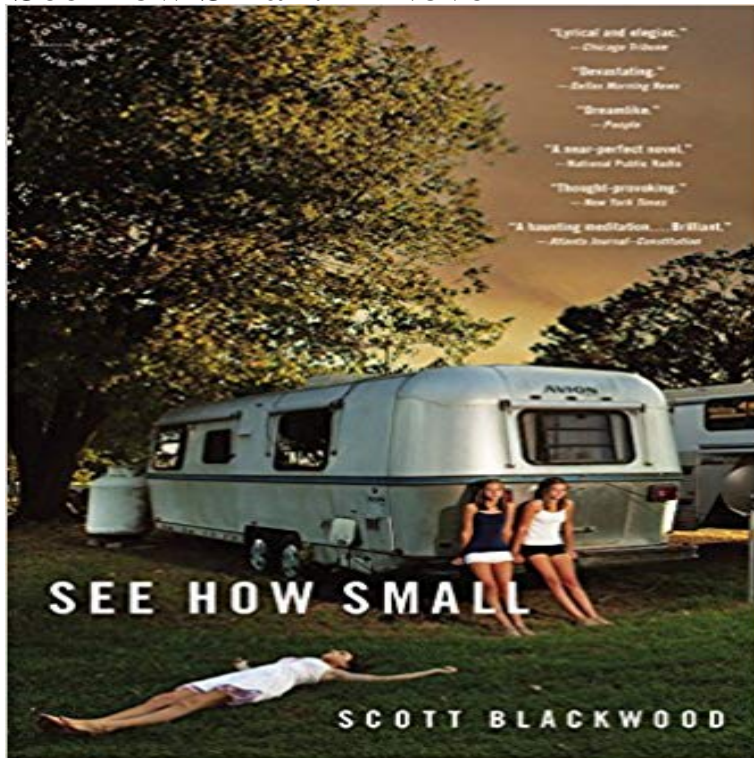


See How Small: A Novel
