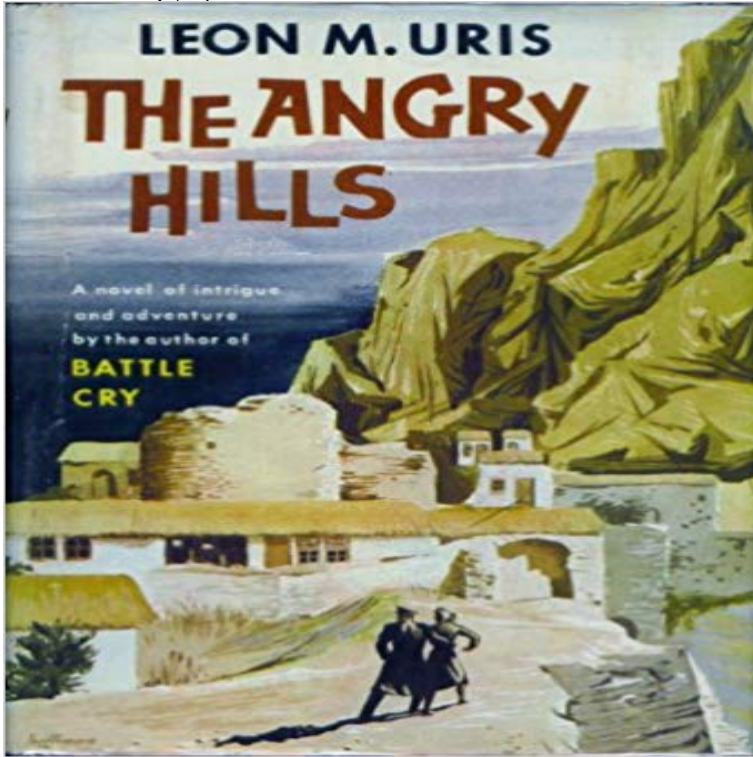


The Angry Hills
