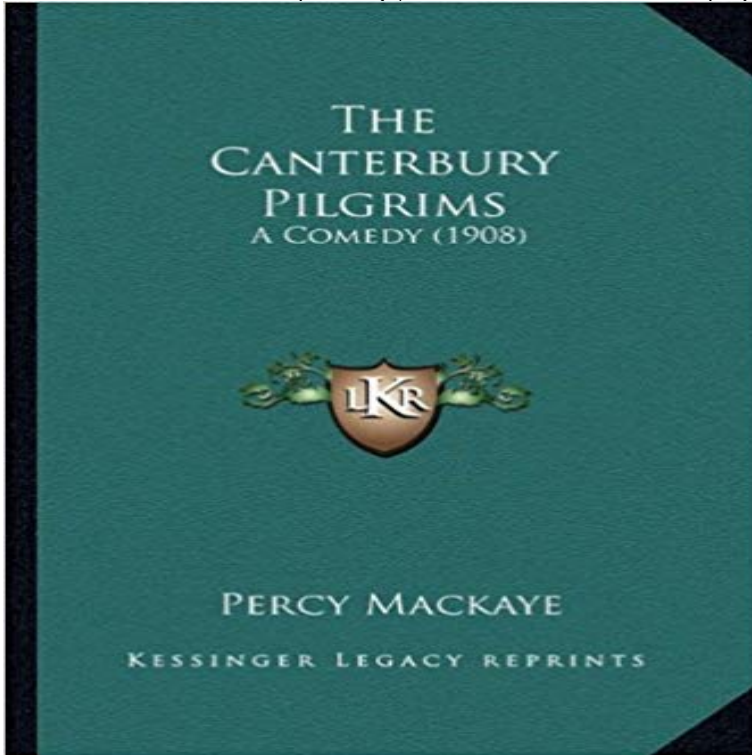


The Canterbury Pilgrims: A Comedy (1908)
