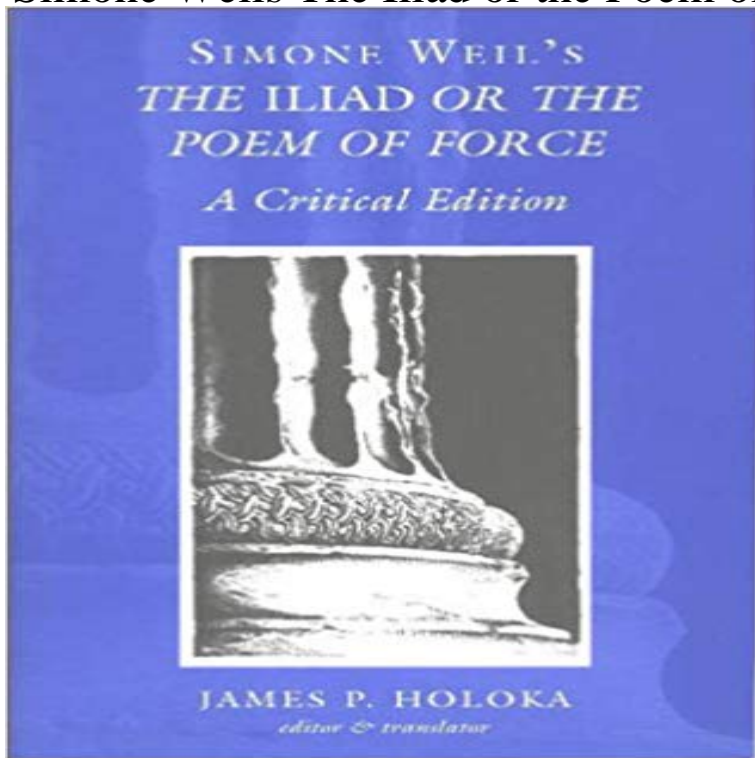


# Simone Weils The Iliad or the Poem of Force: A Critical Edition
