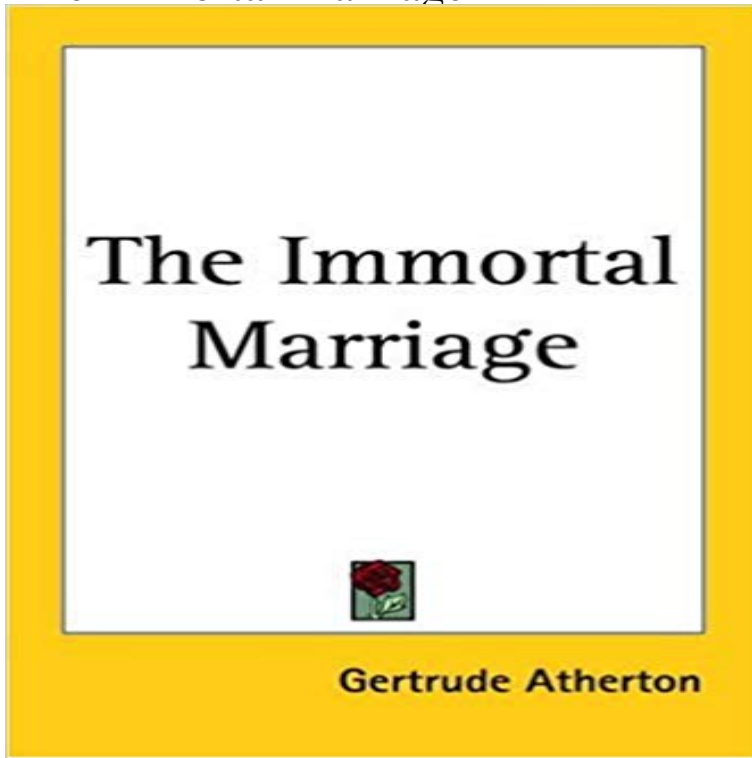


The Immortal Marriage
