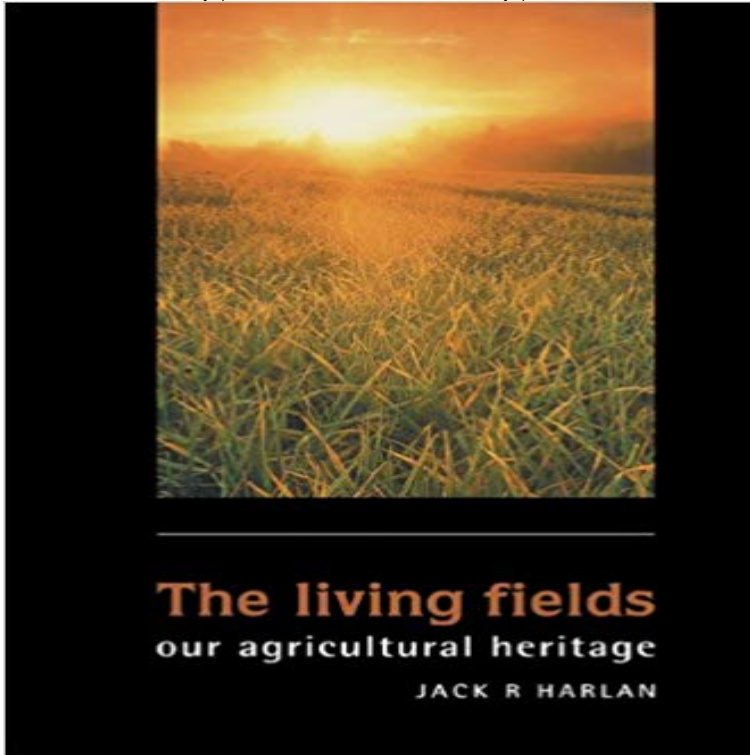


The Living Fields: Our Agricultural Heritage
