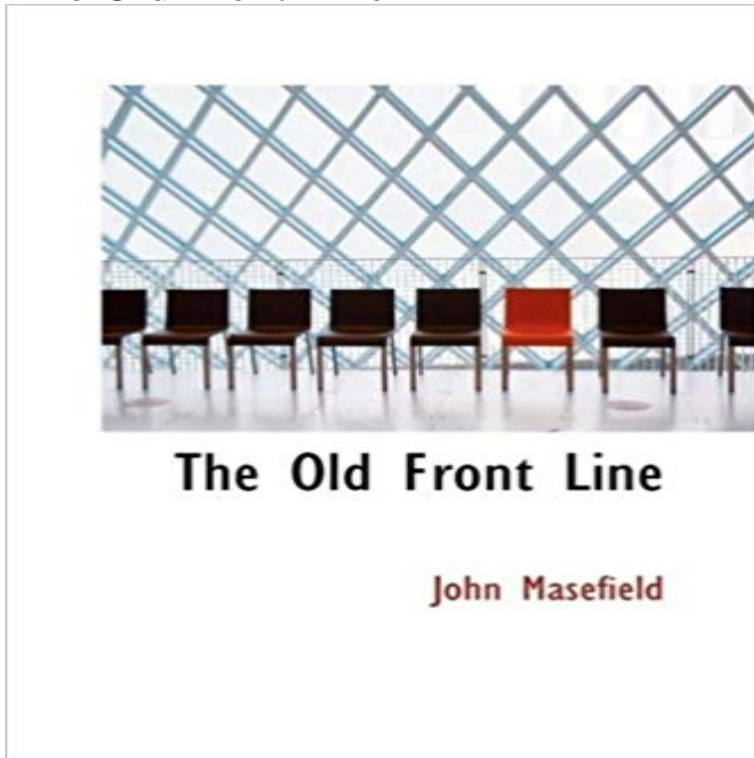


The Old Front Line
