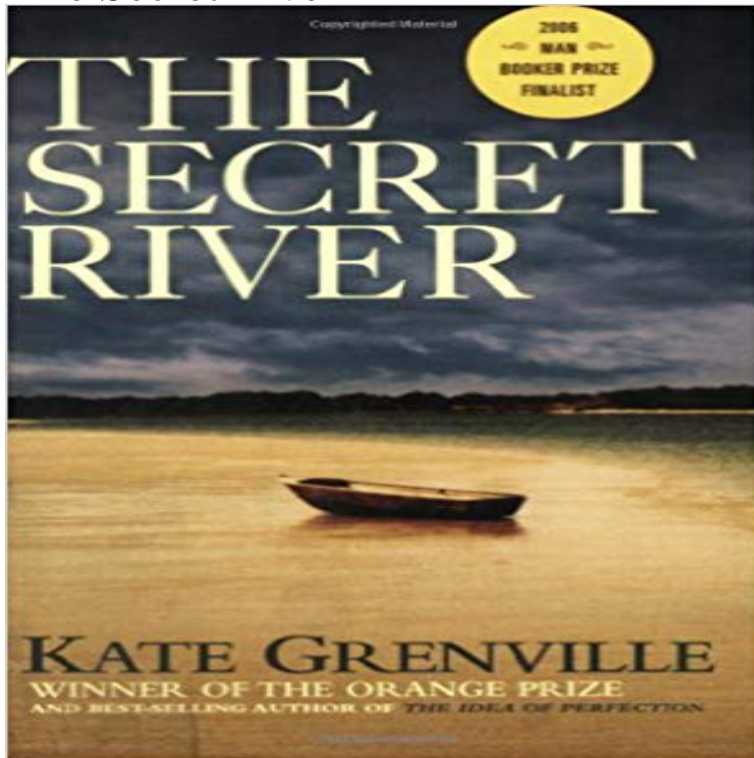


# The Secret River
