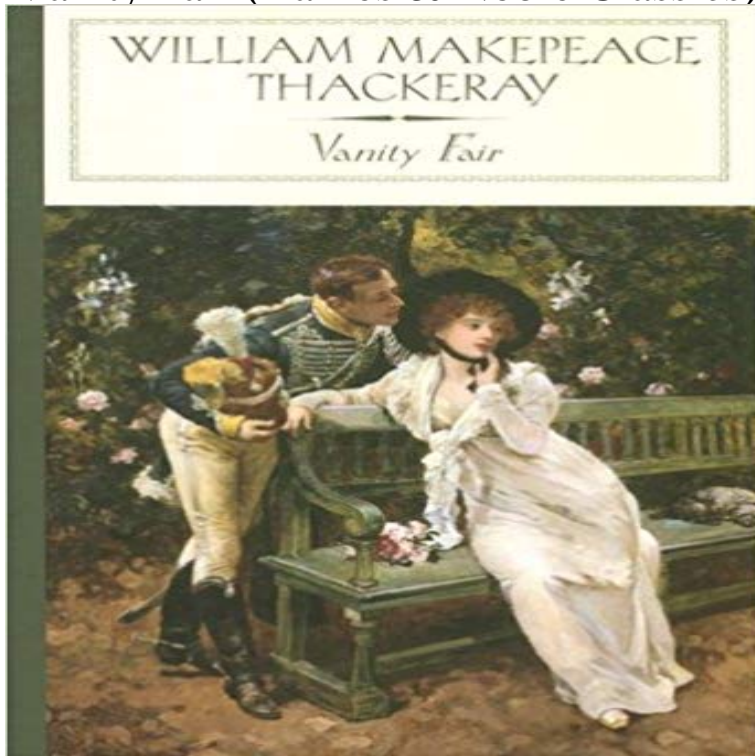


Vanity Fair (Barnes & Noble Classics)
