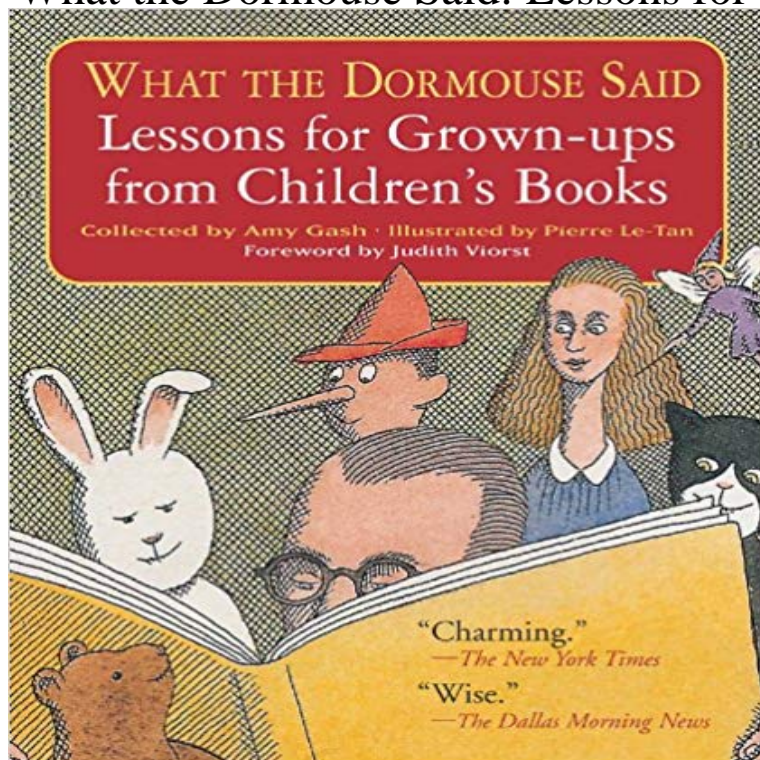


What the Dormouse Said: Lessons for Grown-ups from Childrens Books
